

- Monitor Your Accounts Regularly: Keep an eye on your account activity through online or mobile banking. If you notice anything suspicious, report it to us immediately.
- Be Cautious at ATMs: When withdrawing cash, use ATMs located in well-lit, secure areas (preferably inside banks or reputable businesses) to reduce the risk of card skimming.
- Carry Only What You Need: Bring only the cards and cash you'll need on your trip. Leave unnecessary valuables and financial documents at home to minimize risk.

How to Stay Safe From Phishing Scams

- Check the Sender's Email: Look closely at the sender's address. Even if the name looks familiar, the actual email may be suspicious (e.g., slight misspellings or odd domains).
- Don't Click Suspicious Links: Hover over links to see where they really lead. If it looks strange or doesn't match the context, don't click.
- Be Wary of Urgency: Phishing emails often pressure you with messages like "Your account will be closed!" or "Act immediately!" Legitimate institutions don't usually operate this way.
- Don't Share Sensitive Info Over Email: No reputable organization will ask for passwords, credit card numbers or Social Security numbers via email or text.

- Use Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA): This adds an extra layer of security even if your credentials are compromised.
- Check for Typos and Odd Formatting: Poor grammar, unusual logos or generic greetings (like "Dear User") are red flags.
- Keep Software Updated: Security patches help defend against known vulnerabilities that attackers
- Report Phishing Attempts: Most companies (like banks or tech firms) have dedicated email addresses to report phishing (e.g., phishing@ company.com).
