### Life Insurance Needs

I always like to share with readers the most frequently asked questions for the preceding three months. During the fourth quarter of 2024, that question was: How much life insurance do I need?

The amount of life insurance you need depends on several factors, including your financial obligations, income, lifestyle, and future goals for your family. A common approach is to use one of these methods:

- 1. Income Replacement Method: A typical rule of thumb is getting coverage 10-15 times your annual income. If you earn \$50,000 per year, you might need between \$500,000 and \$750,000 in coverage.
- 2. DIME Formula (Debt, Income, Mortgage, Education): Add the following:
- Debt: Total outstanding loans (excluding
- Income Replacement: Multiply your annual income by the number of years your family will
- Mortgage: The balance on your home loan.

- Education: Estimated cost of college for
- Example: \$50,000 (debt) + \$500,000 (income for 10 years) + \$200,000 (mortgage) + \$200,000 (college for two kids) = \$950,000
- 3. Expense-Based Calculation: If you want more precision, consider:
- Final expenses: Funeral, medical bills, estate costs  $(\sim $10.000 - $20.000).$
- Living expenses for dependents: Cover housing, food, utilities and daily needs.
- Savings gap: If you want to leave a financial cushion.

### 4. Adjust Based on Your Situation

- . If you have substantial savings or assets, you may need less coverage.
- If you have a spouse or dependents who rely heavily on your income, you may need more.
- Consider existing life insurance (e.g., employerprovided policies).
